Getting around Memphis is convenient with several options. The MATA trolley system offers a scenic and affordable way to explore Downtown. Buses serve most neighborhoods, and rideshare services like Uber and Lyft are widely available. Many attractions in Downtown and Midtown are within walking distance, making it easy to explore on foot.

Sample 3-Day Itinerary

Day 1:

- Morning: Tour Graceland, the home of Elvis Presley
- Afternoon: Explore Sun Studio and learn about the birth of rock 'n' roll
- Evening: Enjoy live music and dinner on Beale Street

Day 2:

- Morning: Visit the National Civil Rights Museum
- Afternoon: Walk along the Mississippi Riverfront and explore Tom Lee Park
- Evening: Dine at a local BBQ joint and catch a show at the Orpheum Theatre

Day 3:

- Morning: Visit the Memphis Zoo and Overton Park
- Afternoon: Explore the Cooper-Young neighborhood's shops and cafes
- Evening: Enjoy a sunset dinner at a restaurant in the South Main Arts District
